

Student Clubs, Activities & Unique Opportunities

The HSB adventure begins from the moment students arrive on campus, with orientation providing intensive training by industry experts in management communication and leadership. As the journey continues, HSB students have unique academic and non-academic opportunities at every stage of the MBA program.

HSB students receive the highestquality passive and active support for their internship and job placement. The passive training includes workshops on CV writing, personal branding and career design. It also includes individual coaching in interview and professional portfolio preparation. Active career support includes facilitating internships and placements tailored to student interests. Both services are provided to students at a level equal to the best international programs anywhere in the world. HSB provides company visits, guest lectures and industry panels for students. These visits provide opportunities to learn directly from corporate leaders and entrepreneurs. HSB students also have access to all campus facilities, opportunities and resources, which includes the AIC accelerator for those interested in prototyping their business ideas to launch new ventures.
